Paul Stewart was born in Mississauga, Ontario, Canada in 1977. He graduated from M.M. Robinson High School in Burlington, Ontario in 1996, and qualified as a chef in 1999. He also went to college to study electromechanical engineering but left to pursue a career in hospitality.

His career started in Canada with appointments in Toronto at the King Edward Hotel, the Kings Riding Golf Club, and as Senior Sous Chef at the Rattlesnake Point Golf Club. He then moved to Scotland in 2005 as Sous Chef at the prestigious Prestonfield House Hotel, Edinburgh.

Paul then emigrated to Australia in October 2006 and became the Head Chef at the Mona Vale Hotel, Sydney. Two years later he was appointed to the position of Executive Sous Chef at the Brisbane Hilton Hotel. He was later the Operations Assistant & Functions Chef at the University of Queensland Union, and Executive Chef at the Waterloo Hotel in Fortitude Valley.
